It is with great joy that I share with you updates about St. Ambrose Academy's Christ Our Light building campaign. We may now announce the location of our future school building!

God has led us to the summit of our very own Mount Nebo from where we can look across the Jordan River to our own Promised Land! Along with the Fahey Family, we're happy to make this long-awaited announcement:

Our new home will be located in the Fahey property in Fitchburg. The site is west of McGaw Park (south of Lacy Road) in the southern quadrant of the roundabout at the end of Nobel Drive off Fish Hatchery Road.

What a wonderful occasion to pause for a moment and reflect how our good God led us to this joyful place. Less than three years ago, our generous friends at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish communicated to us their plans to repurpose their religious education wing, which we received as a sign from God that through His grace we had grown to where we could leave the warmth and comfort of the St. Thomas nest and fly to a home all our own.

We have been working since then to build a team of dedicated professionals who have been assisting us with the process of this search for a permanent home and the many important steps involved in a building campaign.

The Christ Our Light building campaign is a milestone in the Madison Catholic educational landscape – the first new Catholic school built in over 50 years. The Church is alive, and Christ is our Light!

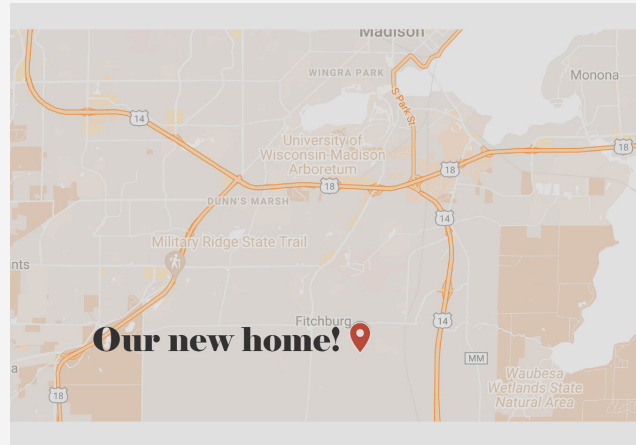
